



Sheriff Christina Corpus Calls for Full Transparency in Measure A Proceedings

Sheriff Christina Corpus is calling for the upcoming Measure A proceedings to be open to the public, a decision she makes with firm conviction. This is her choice, and hers alone. The people of San Mateo County deserve to hear the truth directly, not filtered through political agendas, biased narratives, erroneous reports, or closed-door deliberations.

Until now, Sheriff Corpus has refrained from fully responding to her accusers out of respect for employee privacy and a desire to maintain the integrity of internal processes. But the time has come to bring the truth to light. The community deserves to understand the Sheriff's decisions, the leadership challenges she has faced, violations of her constitutional rights, violation of State and Federal laws, and the deliberate and misleading actions taken by a small group of individuals to remove her from elected office. Sheriff Corpus ran for Sheriff to transform the Department into a world class law enforcement agency. Under her leadership, the Department has made great progress. Crime in San Mateo County is down. The Department has been able to recruit highly qualified, diverse talent. However, transforming the culture of the Department is difficult, and the Sheriff has encountered many obstacles to her reform agenda. It is time for the public to learn directly about the challenges she has confronted.

"This proceeding is not just about me," Sheriff Corpus stated. "It's about exposing the deeply rooted double standards and inequities that persist in our county government—where power, influence, and political alliances too often overshadow fairness, due process, and accountability."

From the start of her term, Sheriff Corpus has led the largest law enforcement agency in San Mateo County with integrity, transparency, and an unwavering commitment to modernizing outdated systems. Her leadership has prioritized reform, equity, fairness, and rebuilding public trust—even in the face of fierce resistance from those who benefit from the status quo.

Sheriff Corpus's statement at the initial hearing was made on the record and in the presence of an attorney representing County counsel. Yet much of what has been said about her since then has gone uncontested and unchallenged filled with

innuendo, leaks, hearsay, and calculated mischaracterizations intended to inflame public opinion and dismantle her reform efforts.
